Project 2020 Update

Over the last few years at St Luke's we have been developing a renewed sense of purpose, leading to an exciting period of development. We recently launched Project 2020 which comprises two stages each containing a number of projects. The first stage, which focuses on external changes to our building and grounds, comprises five projects

- Installation of a new entrance landing and moving steps forward (in effect creating a ramp to the main Church doors)
- Repair to the car park retaining wall
- Replacement of external lobby doors
- New logo writing on the Church front wall
- New notice board (replacing two existing boards)

These projects have successfully gone through the first stage of the process for gaining Diocesan approval and the plans are available for public view.

If you are out taking exercise and want to see what we plan to do, copies of the plans are on display in the windows of the large hall by the car park. Financial Position

Covid -19 is impacting on almost every aspect of our lives, including Church finance. We are currently working through the possible implications for this year's budget and it is already clear that there will be a considerable gap in our finances due to the loss of hall hire income and cessation of Sunday plate collections.

We have been asked by the Diocese to let them know if our financial position will affect our ability to pay the parish share, which unfortunately it will. However, we cannot simply pass our problem back to the Diocese, which is also under considerable financial pressure. As far as we can we must reduce the financial impact ourselves and to this end we expect to announce a series of finance initiatives over the next few weeks.

So at this point could we ask

- those of you who give via envelopes, cash or cheques to consider switching to standing orders. This will help us with our cash flow and enable us to pay as much of the parish share as possible

- you to consider whether you could increase your level of giving.
